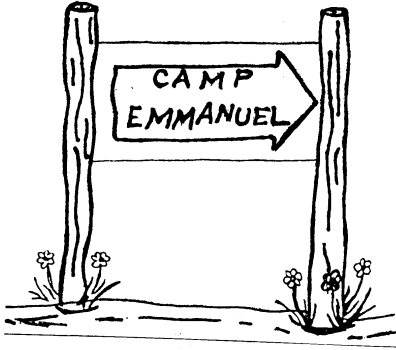

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Camp Emmanuel is a Christian campground owned and operated by the Illinois/Wisconsin District of the Church of the Brethren. **All who participate in the camping programs or use the facilities are expected to demonstrate a spirit of Christian fellowship.** While at camp, you will have the opportunity to study about God and His workings among the things He created and placed on earth for our use and enjoyment. There will be time for play, recreation, hiking, music, adventure, swimming, worship, study and work. It is good to attend camp expecting to learn new things, meet new people, and have a good time. Certain dietary restrictions can be accommodated upon **prior** request.

## COME PREPARED - BRING THESE THINGS

All campers, counselors, directors, and others attending camp for the week should bring the following items.

- Bedding:** Bring your own bed linens including; pillows, sheets, blankets, or a sleeping bag.
- Clothing:** Bring modest and sufficient clothing for the duration of your camp. Tank tops, tube tops, tight or revealing clothes are not to be worn at camp. Several sets of clothes are needed. Tennis shoes, other comfortable shoes, bath or shower shoes, casual clothing, cap or hat, warm jacket or sweat shirt, rain gear and an **appropriate** swim suit should also be packed.
- Personal Items:** Please bring your own towels, soap, tooth brush/paste, wash cloth and other items for personal cleanliness.
- Miscellaneous:** Campers will also want to come prepared for all activities. A Bible, notebook, pen and pencil, camera, flashlight, insect repellent, ball glove, and fishing equipment are some of the items you may want to bring.

## ITEMS NOT PERMITTED AT CAMP

Radios, tape or CD players, televisions, video games, soda, candy, snack foods, tobacco products, alcohol, or fireworks are not appropriate for the camp setting. These things should not be brought or sent to camp. Occasionally TV's and VCR's are used in the camping program. If necessary, these items will be provided by the director or counselor.

***Pets brought to camp must be kept on a leash and are restricted to the housekeeping cabins and RV areas.***

## WHEN TO ARRIVE AT CAMP

Please **DO NOT** drop off campers earlier than indicated as there is no one to supervise them and other camps may be in session. Come to the Porch to register when you arrive at camp.

## TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

**From the North:** Take route 24 to Astoria, turn South on Pearl Street, travel 3 miles, turn left at CAMP EMMANUEL sign.  
**From the South:** Cross the Illinois River at Beardstown on Rt. 125 North. Turn Right on Route 100. Proceed through Frederick and turn left in Browning at the Post Office. Follow the road North out of town, through Bader, and when the road turns right after passing the red barn on the left, go straight North. Turn right at the CAMP EMMANUEL sign in 1 mile.
