

## About Camp

Summer camp is a special time for children to gently explore and enrich their relationship with God. They spend a week working together in small groups, learning to cooperate. This leads to strong and enduring friendships. Cabin leaders spend the entire day and night accompanying the campers through the week. Activities include daily bible study, crafts, swimming, canoeing, games, and campfires.

## Accommodations

Campers stay with their counselor in a modern bunk room. A tiled bathroom is attached.

## Ages

Kids Camp, age 6 by 9/1/08

Junior Camp, age 9 by 9/1/08 or having completed 3rd grade.

Junior High Camp, age 12 by 9/1/08 or having completed 6th grade.

Youth Camp, age 15 by 9/1/08 or having completed 9th grade.

No exceptions will be made.

## Meals

Three balanced meals each day plus an evening snack.

## Health Insurance

For the safety of each camper:

1. Accident and sickness insurance is provided as a supplement to the camper's personal coverage.
2. All medication will be kept by the camp director.
3. All campers will be screened by the camp director at

registration. 4. In the event of an emergency, a reasonable effort will be made to contact parents. 5. Ill or injured campers will be taken to one of several nearby medical facilities.

## What to bring:

Bible, medicines, balance due, small fan, pillow, sleeping bag or linens, flashlight, offering money, bug repellent, camera, swim suit, sun block, 2 pair of shoes, swim towel, shower towel, soap shampoo, brush, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, bed clothes, extra socks, & 7 changes of clothes (3 for Kids Camp). Optional: paper, pencil, envelopes with stamps, and musical instrument. Spending money – there is a camp store.

Leave these items at home: candy, shaving cream, squirt guns, electronic games, radios, phones, beepers, weapons.

## Scholarships

Assistance may be available through your local church. Camperships are also available from the camp, and should be requested in advance.

## Field Trips

Campers leave the site only for supervised field trips within easy walking distance of the camp. Youth Resident Camp, Senior Hi Adventure Camp and Jr Hi Adventure Camp includes off-site camping and service trips around Orlando.

## Volunteer

Parents can volunteer at camp by contacting Camp Director Mike Neff. Positions vary from kitchen help, crafts help, grocery runs, special events, and recreation help.

## Visits

Parents and friends are invited to tour camp and meet counselors when bringing their children to camp. If a camper must be

contacted during the week, please see the Camp Director first.

## Personal Conduct

All who attend are expected to live together as a Christian community and to adhere to high standards of conduct. Bullying is not allowed. Clothing must be modest and appropriate. Undergarments must be out of view. Foot protection is required. Campers not abiding by the rules will be dismissed.

## Check In/Out

-Kids Camp: 5pm Fri. until 2pm Sunday.

-Junior: 5pm Sun. until 10am Saturday.

-Junior Hi.: 4pm Sunday until 5pm Friday.

-Youth: 4pm Sunday until 10am Saturday.

-Adventure Camp: 4pm Sun until 10am Sat.

-CIT Camp, Noon Sat. until 5pm Wed.

-Family Camp, 7pm Fri. until 10am Mon.

*Campers being picked up by someone other than the parent or legal guardian must notify the Camp Director.*

## Refund Policy

Full refunds, less \$10 for registration, will be given until four weeks prior to camp. After this time, one half refunds, less \$10.00 for registration, will be given. Campers sent home because of personal conduct will not receive a refund.

## Registration

1. Fill out the attached registration form
2. Complete the medical information, emergency form, and sign.
3. Complete the camper contract and sign.
4. Send 1/2 Fee. Balance is due at camp.
5. Make checks payable to: Camp Ithiel
6. Campers will not be admitted without all completed, signed forms.
7. Registration is limited, and will be on a **first come first served** basis.
