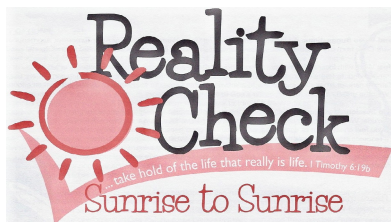


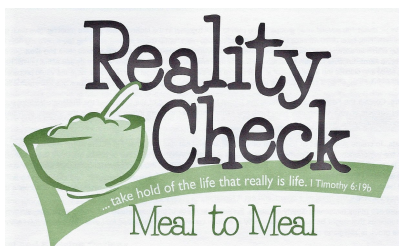
Licensed to Spend: Learning to Drive the Money Machine

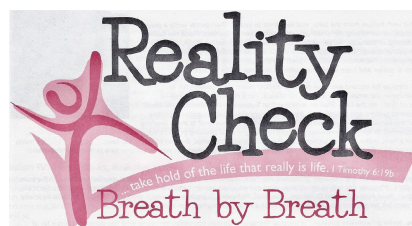
Waking Up to God's Creation
