

BERMUDIAN

Rt. 30 South/East/West - Turn north at the Abbottstown traffic circle onto Rt. 194. After the traffic light in East Berlin (center of town) continue on 194 for another 2.1 miles, and turn right onto Bermudian Church Road. Go 2.1 miles to stop sign at Davidsburg Rd. Go straight, church is ½ mile on the left.

From York area - Follow Rt. 74 north to Davidsburg Rd. traffic signal, turn left (Nellies Restaurant on your left & CVS Pharmacy just past the light on your left.) Proceed 6.8 miles on Davidsburg Rd., turn right onto Bermudian Church Rd., church is ½ mile on the left.

Rt. 74 / Rt. 15 North/West - Follow Rt. 15 south to the light at Rt. 74 south in Dillsburg (Wendy's on your right at the light & a Chevrolet dealer on your left.) Turn left onto Rt. 74 through Dillsburg to the intersection just past the Northern York Schools complex. Rt. 74 turns left, you want to proceed straight onto Rt. 194. Proceed south 8 miles through Franklintown to Davidsburg Rd. *(This is an easy intersection to miss - there is a large white sign, "East Berlin Fish & Game Association" on your right. The road to the right is called Bakers Watering Trough Rd, to the left is Davidsburg Rd.)* Turn left onto Davidsburg Rd., proceed 2.1 miles to Bermudian Church Rd. Turn left. Church is ½ mile on the left.

(If you get to the traffic light in East Berlin you missed Davidsburg Rd. Turn around & follow the "south/east & west" directions above from the East Berlin light.)
