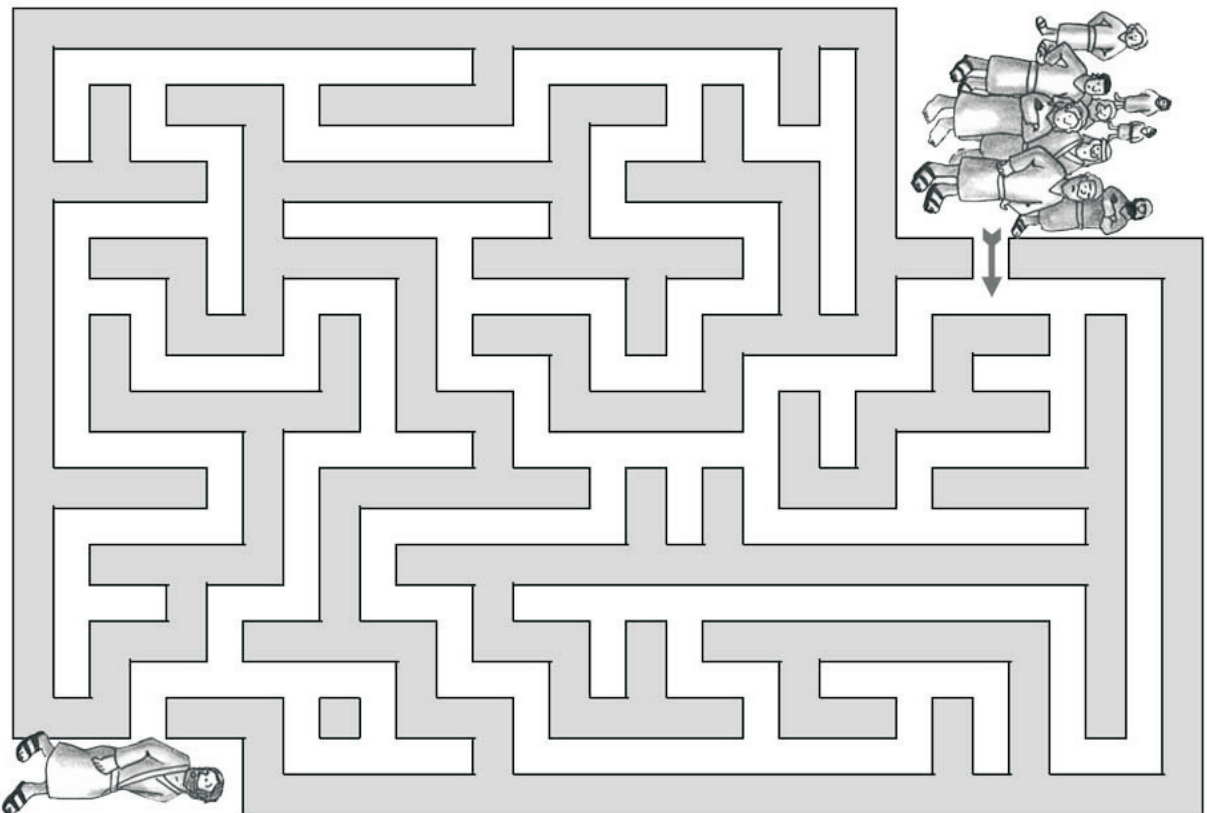


Jesus slipped through the crowd and went away.

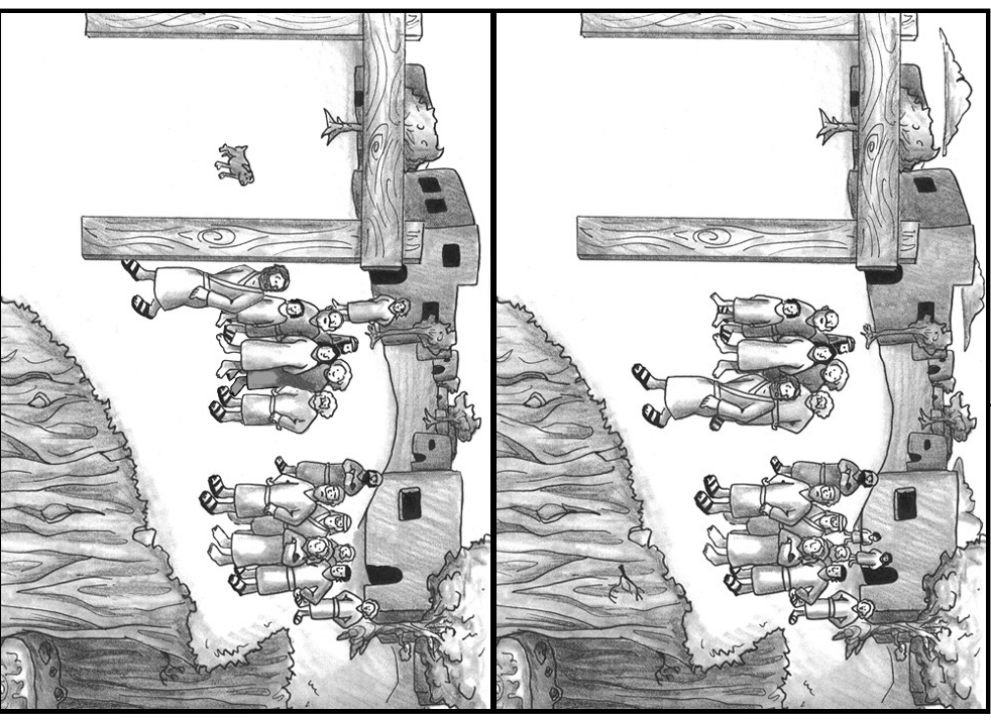

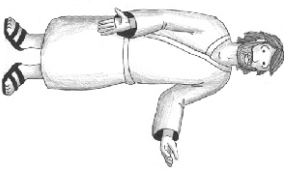
