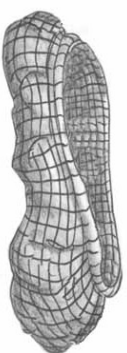
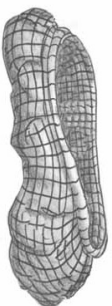
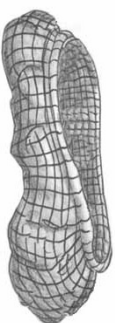
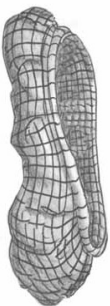
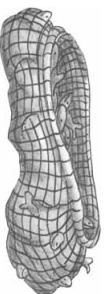
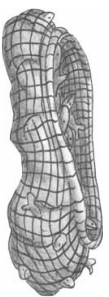


Find the net that is full of fish.

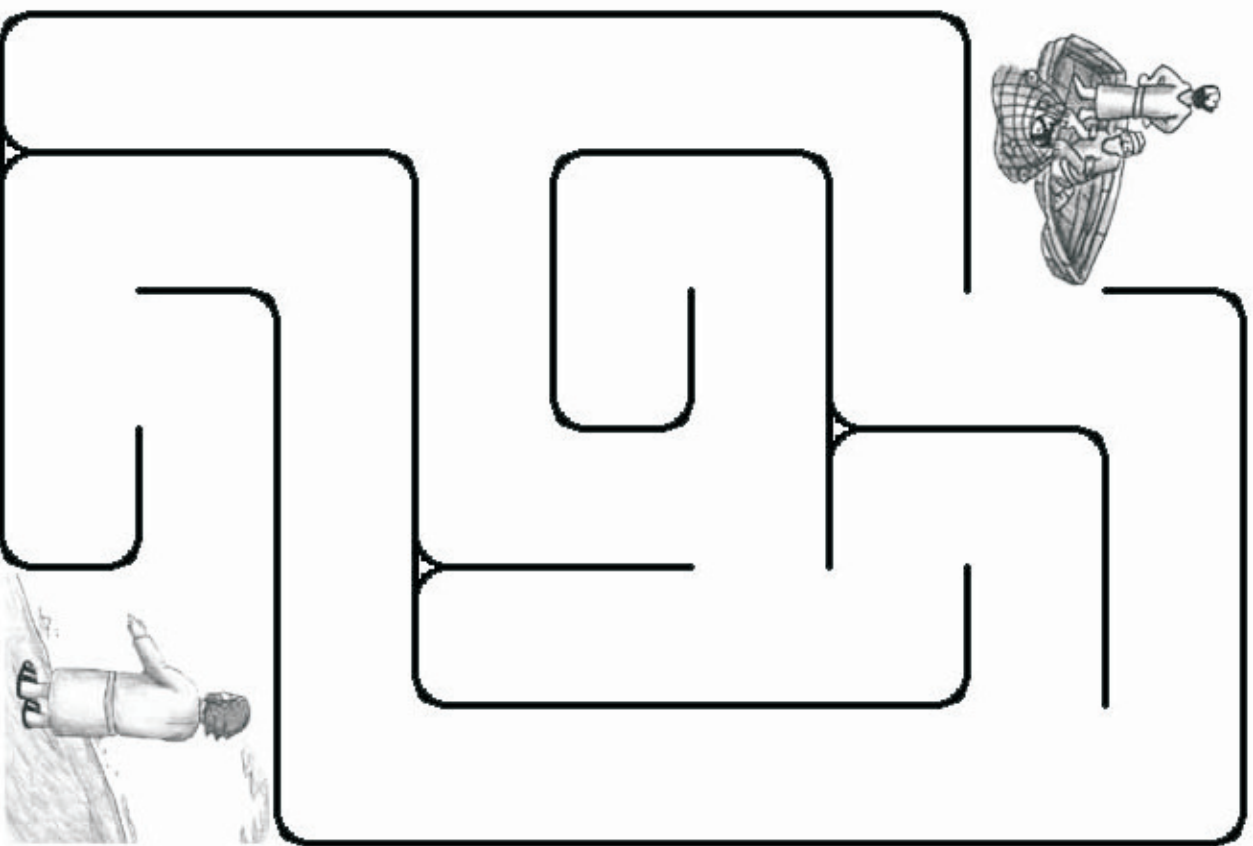
